Apr Do a **bug safari!** How many different kinds of **invertebrates** (invertebrates) can you find? Try looking under rocks and in bushes.

May Go **birdwatching** and spot the first **swift** of the season!

Jun Make a bird's **nest** using twigs and leaves on the ground. Can you find and compare two nests?

Jul Copy the birds with **worm** charming! Stamp on the grass singing a song, then step back and see all the worms that have come up from the soil!

AUTUMN & WINTER

Sep Make a **habitat heap** by gathering lots of twigs and leaves into a big cosy pile somewhere sheltered (away from paths and next to/under bushes).

Oct Investigate the **trees, leaves and seeds**. Try throwing sycamore seeds in the air and watch them fall as helicopters!

Nov Look at the **colourful fallen leaves**. What kind of tree are they from? What do they look and feel like?

Dec Can you see any **fabulous fungi** growing on or around tree trunks? Remember not to touch.

Jan Use a stick in the mud and make some **footprints!** How different are the prints of ducks, dogs, pigeons and squirrels?

THINGS TO DO IN THE PARK

Call out to one of the **birds** you hear by mimicking the sound it makes.

Splash in any puddles you see!

Nature is full of **colour**, how many different colours can you find?

Helping to give nature a home:

ALL YEAR ROUND ACTIVITIES

Become a habitat explorer! A habitat is a place where an animal lives. How many different habitats can you find in the park? What lives there?

Do a wildlife survey! How many squirrels did you spot in the park?

Gently pick up a woodlouse and look at it up close. How many legs does it have? How does it move?

Remember to put your little creatures **gently** back where you found them.

Hop like a **frog** and crawl like a **toad**. Which do you think is faster? Which has longer legs?

ALL YEAR ROUND ACTIVITIES

Pick up a stick to use as a wand, memorise the **scientific name** for a creature, then say it out loud, like you're **casting a spell!**

Bombus lucorum!

Can you spot any animal **tracks and signs?** Footprints, hair, nibbled pine cones or nuts? Tell a story of who made them and what they were doing.
