Our Education Programme

- Year 1 – 4000 local primary school children received in-curriculum golf coaching.
- 14 schools with over 1500 children attended School Festival at Golf It! in August
- Year 2 - we will work with 20 schools with the goal of 6000 pupils.
- In 5 years, we will work with 42,500 school children.
- Teachers receive CPD training to continue delivering golf sessions once programme is complete.





The Bridge to Golf

- Working with Active Schools and Pastoral Teachers, we are identifying pupils who require free golf coaching
- Life skills, health, wellbeing and care at the forefront of selection
- 1:1 coaching will be offered to those requiring this or those who show real talent
- Scholarship led by our PGA professionals

- Working with Ian McDonald from Catch the Light, we have developed a volunteering programme to create opportunities for people in the local community. Areas of work include

Sustainable Future



- Our Hub is powered by 100% renewable energy. We host electric car charging stations for visitors and use electric mowers on the course, all reducing noise, air pollution and carbon.
- We are proud of the incredible variety of wildlife that call Golf It! home and, with the help of expert ecologists, encourage and protect it. While exploring the nature trails keep an eye out for the safe areas we've set aside for water voles, the bug hotels, bird and bat boxes and wildflower meadows and, of course our resident heard of Roe Deer.
- From turf grass selection to course design, everything has been considered to reduce inputs like water and fertiliser and to maximise the ecological value of the course.
