

## Secondary Art - Drawing School





## **Quick Abstract Line**

You will need an envelope with clear window, coloured pens, and a permanent dark coloured marker.

Start by trimming off the side seams of the envelope and the opening flap so you are left with the part that opens like a card.

Mark inside the envelope where all the corners of the clear window are. You now have your drawing area.

Using bold gestures and vibrant colour quickly mark out all the large areas of colour you see in the painting inside your drawing area.

Close the envelope and use your permanent marker to create areas of detail using fast confident marks.
