## Find this watercolour painting.

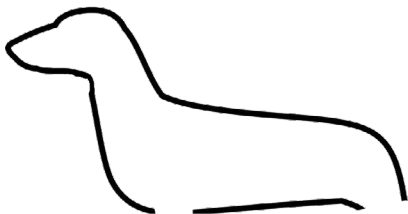
It was painted by Joseph Crawhall.
